
As you are aware, week-wise activities have started off and picked up pace with many States/Panchayats coming forward to conduct thematic events on weekly basis as part of *Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav*. To keep tracking / reporting of various activities carried out at State /UT headquarters and Panchayat levels across the country, the URL of live India@75 portal/ dashboard has become operational and it can be accessible through the following URL link: <http://indiaat75.nic.in/>. A few States / UTs have already created login credentials for Nodal Officers for India@75 (Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav) at District and Block level on the dashboard, which has started capturing the progress of activities undertaken at District / Block/ Gram Panchayat level to celebrate Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav in order to allow the Ministry to quickly see progress made by various Panchayati Raj Institutions / Rural Local Bodies.

2. In this regard, we have regularly been requesting State/UT Departments of Panchayati Raj to provide name and contact-details (email address and mobile number) of **Nodal Officers** designated for *Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav* (India@75) at email: <ak.tiwari12@nic.in> so that necessary entries for creation of State/UT-level Nodal Officers can be made at national level. Entries in respect of Nodal Officers for different levels such as District Panchayat and Intermediate Panchayat will be made by State/UT Nodal Officer and District Nodal Officers respectively. However, Gram Panchayats will be able to access to the India@75 portal using their login credentials for eGramSwaraj portal. Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for India@75 Reporting Dashboard is enclosed herewith. Since necessary details regarding Nodal Officers are still awaited from a few States/UTs, their login users are yet to be created on the **India@75 Dashboard** (<http://indiaat75.nic.in/>).

3. In view of the importance of the matter, I would like to request the **State/UT Departments of Panchayati Raj** of (i) Assam, (ii) Bihar, (iii) Maharashtra, (iv) Meghalaya, (v) Nagaland, (vi) Odisha, (vii) West Bengal, (viii) Jammu & Kashmir, (ix) Lakshadweep and (x) Puducherry to designate an Officer as **Nodal Officer for India@75** for better and smooth coordination with MoPR and PRIs for implementation of week-wise activities and provide their names and contact-details to the Ministry at the earliest so that **Nodal Officers' credentials can be created for India@75 Dashboard**. I would like to request all the States/UTs to provide the above information latest by **9th August 2021** at email: <ak.tiwari12@nic.in>.
