NOTIFICATION

ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR

No. FIN/FC-50/2012

Dated Itanagar, the 23rd August, 2012.

In pursuance of the provisions of Article 243-I and Article 243-Y of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to constitute the Second Arunachal Pradesh State Finance Commission with the following members:-

1. Smt. Fantry Mein Jaswal, IRS (Retired) : Chairperson,
2. Secretary (Panchayati Raj) : Ex-officio Member,
3. Special Secretary (Finance) : Ex-officio Member.

The Commission may be assisted by a full time Secretary who should be of the rank of Joint Secretary in the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh.

2. The Commission shall make recommendations on the following matters:
 - (a) The principles which should govern the distribution between the State Govt. and the Local Bodies (LBs) i.e. Zila Parishads, Anchal Samitis, Gram Panchayats and Municipalities of the net proceeds of taxes, duties, tolls and fees leviable by the State Govt. which may be divided between them and the inter-se allocation between Zila Parishads, Anchal Samitis, Gram Panchayats and Municipalities of their respective shares of such proceeds;
 - (b) The determination of the taxes, duties, tolls and fees which may be assigned to, or appropriated by the Zila Parishads, Anchal Samitis, Gram Panchayats and Municipalities from the Consolidated Fund of the State;
 - (c) The grants-in-aid to the Zila Parishads, Anchal Samitis, Gram Panchayats and Municipalities from the Consolidated Fund of the State;
 - (d) The measures needed to improve the financial position of the Zila Parishads, Anchal Samitis, Gram Panchayats and Municipalities; and
 - (e) Any other matter referred to the State Finance Commission in the interest of sound finances of the Zila Parishads, Anchal Samitis, Gram Panchayats and Municipalities.

3. In making its recommendations, the Commission shall have regard, among other considerations to:

- (i) The objective of balancing the receipts and expenditure on revenue account both the local bodies as a whole and the State Govt. and each local body;
- (ii) The resources of the State Govt. and the demand thereon, in particular, on account of expenditure on maintenance of law &

order, civil administration, debt servicing and other committed expenditures;

- (iii) The revenue of the resources of the local bodies for the five years commencing on 1st April, 2015 on the basis of the level of the collection to be made during 2013-14 from taxes, duties, tolls, fees, cess, etc. by them;
- (iv) The potential for raising additional revenue from the existing sources available to them; and
- (v) The scope for better financial management consistent with efficiency and economy in expenditures.

4. In making its recommendations on the various aforesaid matters, the Commission shall adopt the population figures of latest census available in all cases where population is regarded as a factor for determination of devolution of taxes and duties and grant-in-aid.

5. The Commission shall indicate the basis on which it has arrived at its findings and make available the local body-wise estimates of receipts and expenditure.

6. The Commission shall make its report available to the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh by 30th September, 2013 on each of the aforesaid matters covering period of 5 (five) years commencing on the 1st April, 2015.
